### **We're investing to upgrade the power supply**

Hello. We're Electricity North West and we operate your local electricity network.

We're working through phase one of a major project which will see us invest £1m upgrading the power supply in Windermere and Bowness. The work we're carrying out will allow for the installation of Windermere's first electric ferry as well as provide additional capacity for low carbon technologies such as electric vehicle charging points.

A lot of our network was installed in the 1950s and 60s and it's vital we carry out these works now as the region becomes more reliant on electricity.

### **How this will affect you**

- From February 27<sup>th</sup> for approximately three weeks, engineers will work on the B5285 Ferry Road which will be closed. However, access will remain for all businesses and residents.
- This work will transition onto the B5285 ferry rd under temporary traffic lights for approximately 3 further weeks.
- The A592 will then be set up with 2 way rolling lights as we move from the ferry rd to Glebe rd over a period of 3 weeks.
- We currently have a second site on Lake rd under two way lights which will continue through the next few weeks until this section is complete.
- Although access to properties may be restricted throughout the works, plans will be put in place to minimise the impact on residents, tourists and businesses.
- All works taking place have been agreed with Cumbria County Council.
