



We're investing to upgrade Manchester's electricity network

What's happening

We're carrying out essential upgrades on the electricity network in Hulme as part of the Southern Gateway project. This £6.5m investment will strengthen Manchester's electricity network to support future homes, businesses, development projects and essential services across the city.

What work will take place

The work requires us to dig in the road and install new underground electricity cables. To keep disruption to a minimum, we're also installing a new connection at the same time for essential services.

Why is the work needed?

Manchester is growing and demand for electricity continues to increase.

This investment will help:

- Support future development across the city.
- Improve the reliability of the power network.
- Enable a new connection for essential services.

We always aim to carry out our work as planned and with as little disruption as possible. However, the dates we publish for road works can sometimes change. This is because a number of factors outside our control can affect when it is safe or practical for our teams to work, such as weather, ground conditions and emergency repairs.

What disruption can I expect?

To keep engineers and the public safe, temporary traffic management will be required at various stages of the project, including:

- Temporary road closures
- Diversion routes
- Temporary traffic lights
- Temporary suspension of parking bays

We're working closely with Manchester City Council to plan the work and minimise disruption wherever possible.

Residents and businesses impacted will receive further information ahead of work taking place providing specific locations and dates.

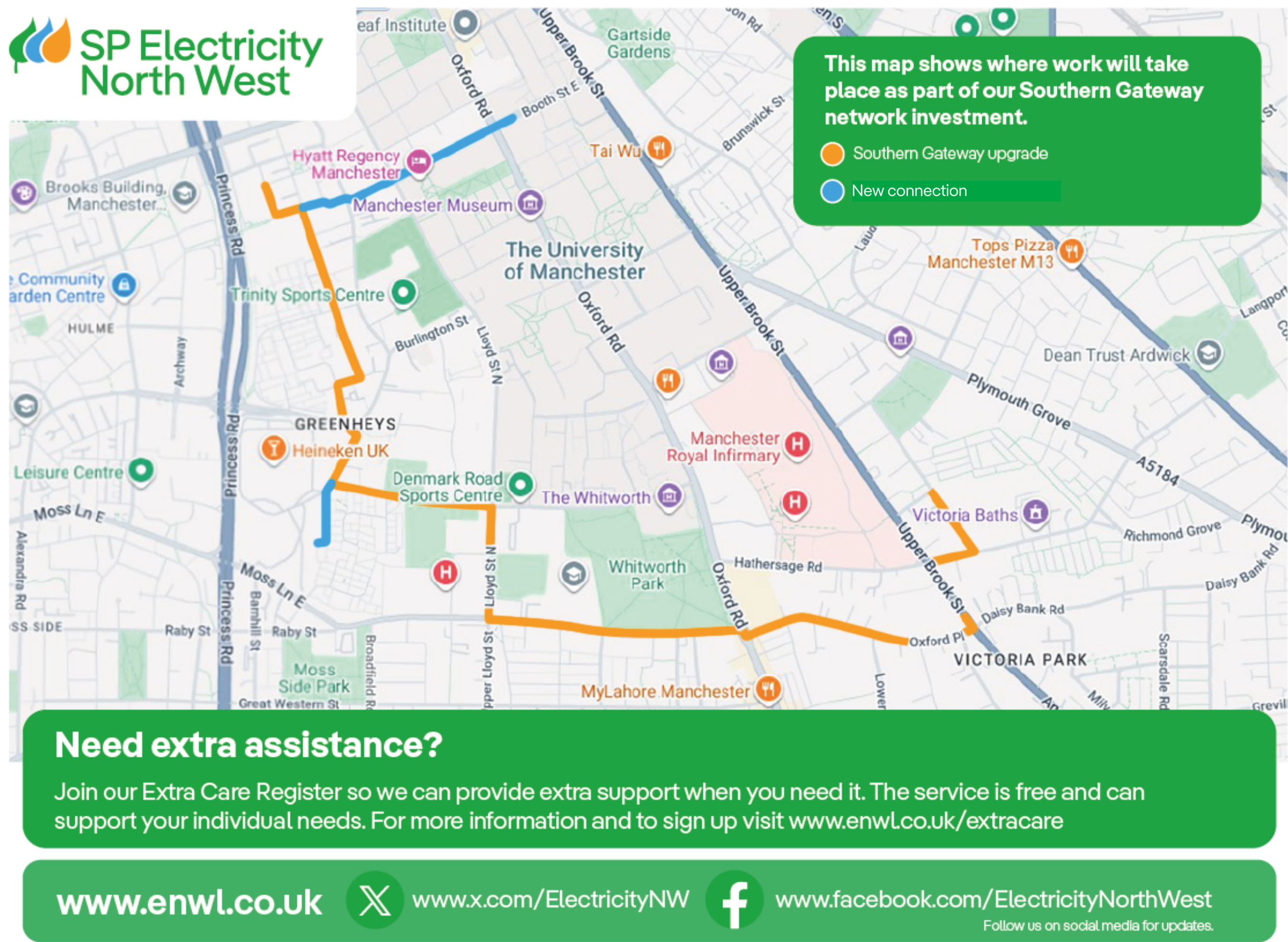
