



Expression of Interest in Electricity North West's flexibility requirements in RIIO-ED2

Survey results

February 2021

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This expression of interest highlights 21 locations on our grid and primary network (from 132kV down to 6.6kV) where we think we'll require flexible services in the future, due to network constraints.

We asked flexibility providers to express an interest in providing us with flexibility in the next price control period, from 2023 to 2028 to identify the current level of flexibility available on the network and obtain information on how much flexibility could potentially be available in the future.




## EoI survey results- February 2021

Q. If you are not already connected to the network; are you anticipating a connection to the network?







