

View our assets


You can use the map to navigate to a specific location, or search for an asset in the following ways:

- 1. By substation name or number, e.g. Citadel / 638094
- 2. Using co-ordinates:
 - a. Easting and northings, e.g. 349398, 434762
 - b. Longitude and latitude, e.g. -2.7031, 53.7632
- 3. By postcode, e.g. PR1 6LB
- 4. By SPN (Structured Plant Number), e.g. 4106470ST001
- 5. By FID (Feature Identifier), e.g. 5632498
- 6. By pole or tower number, using SPN or FID.






Trace our assets

Our Network Asset Viewer allows you to add point and line assets from the map to a workspace on the right-hand side of the screen, so you can build a trace of the network within the map view.



Network Asset Viewer User guidance

Click on the 'plus' symbol to add it to your list of assets to trace in the 'workspace'.



You can add more assets to trace in the same way, and your previously selected assets will stay highlighted in magenta on the map view.



The assets that you have selected to trace will appear in the 'workspace' to the right of the map view.

From the 'workspace' you can click on an asset to zoom into it on the map view, or you can delete it by clicking the bin symbol.
