Why is switchgear maintenance important?

"Electricity kills and injures people. Around 1,000 electrical accidents at work are reported to Health and Safety Executive (HSE) each year and about 30 people die of their injuries."

Many deaths and injuries arise from the use of poorly maintained electrical equipment. It is essential that your low voltage switchgear is regularly inspected and maintained to meet current legal requirements.

Under the cover of one of our maintenance agreements, Electricity North West will ensure that your low voltage switchgear is fully compliant with the required legislation including the Electricity at Work Regulations (1989).

What do the Regulations require you to do?

By law you are required to have management systems that will ensure safe operation and maintenance of equipment to minimise the risk of injury.

In addition, owners and operators are required to assess their electrical system to identify any potential risks and issues.

Section 4 of the Electricity at Work (1989) Regulations states;

"As may be necessary to prevent danger, all systems shall be maintained so as to prevent so far as reasonably practicable, such danger."

It is the responsibility of the asset owner/operator to maintain their low voltage switchgear to the required standards. Correctly compiled certificates and reports demonstrate that the necessary inspection and testing of equipment has been carried out.
